For 85 years Alliance Academy International (AAI) Quito, Ecuador, has produced international leaders who are initiators of change in our world. All AAI faculty and staff are committed Christians with the goal to develop students into ambassadors for Jesus Christ who live with a focus on eternity, while educating students with a U.S. style of Christian education, based on the highest standards of academic excellence.

AAI faculty, staff, and administration see the community as their mission field. AAI ministers in the following ways:

To Students:

- **In the Classroom** – All faculty and staff are committed Christians, and have the opportunity to share with their students about Jesus Christ throughout the school day. Teachers pray for and with students, while teaching them to love the Lord.
- **Through Chapel** – Early Childhood and Elementary Students have Chapel once a week, where they worship Jesus Christ.
- **Through Extracurricular Activities** – Students are taught to serve others through sports, activities and service projects in the community.
- **Through Mentorship** – Teachers, faculty and staff take on the role of mentors with students, and help disciple them into young adults that love learning and sharing about Jesus Christ.
- **DNA (Discipleship, Nurturing, Accountability)** – Middle and High School students take advantage of weekly DNA activities, where they are mentored and disciplined by a staff / faculty member, and share with others who have common interests.



To Parents:

- **Through Chapel** – Parents are welcome to join their children in Chapel and reinforce all the chapel learnings in their homes.
- **Center for Family Support** – This support group provides prayer and guidance for families based upon a Biblical understanding of the family's role from God's perspective.
- **Women and Men Christian Bible Study and Support Groups** – Parents can take advantage of Bible studies and support groups available several times throughout the week.



To Each Other:

- **Spiritual Life support** – A spiritual life director is dedicated to pouring into the lives of the AAI Faculty and Staff.
- **Spiritual Life Weekends** – AAI dedicates one weekend a month to spiritual life getaways in Calacali's training and discipleship center.
- **Professional Development** – All AAI faculty and staff have the ability to invest in themselves through professional development training.
- **Staff Bible Study, Prayer and Support Groups** - AAI hosts several bible studies and support groups to help minister to those who are ministering to the AAI students.

- **CSO (Community Service Outreach)** - AAI shares the love of Jesus Christ in the community weekly through Community Service Outreach, such as working with orphanages, the garbage dump, inner city schools, and more.
